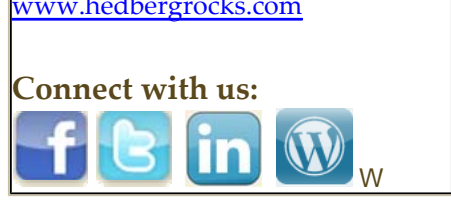

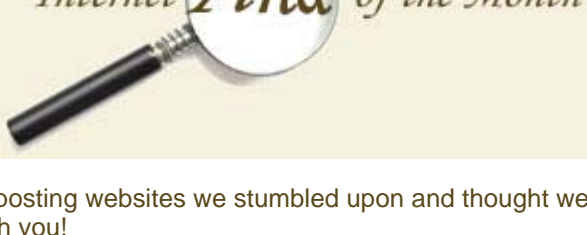
**Tips for September**

- It's a good time, now that the temperatures are cooling down, to get some fertilizer on established lawns.
- Next years' dandelions are lurking in your lawn right now. Use a broadleaf weed spray to get them killed as they are young and easily killed right now.
- It's a great time to plant a tree! [\(All Trees are 25% off at Hedberg\)](#) There is still plenty of time to get in a shade tree, whether it be a deciduous tree, such as a maple, oak or linden, or even an evergreen, such as a pine or spruce. Be sure you water it in well, and make sure it gets a good watering once a week if the rains don't come. Mulch in your tree with a layer of wood chips 3" thick.

**Tree of the Month**

**Swamp White Oak**  
*Quercus bicolor,*

B&B Excellent in both wet and upland soils, this tree has a coarser, less deeply incised leaf than Q. alba, and acorns borne on 2- 4" stalks. It shows good transplant success. This oak is a fast grower and widely specified in the landscape. It is very tolerant of most soil conditions. It is a spring dig only tree and should be planted by Oct 1. Prefers acidic soil which is common for most oak trees. Growth Characteristics: This tree grows to a mature height of 60 feet. Swamp white oak are very resistant to oak wilt. Bark is very textured. As in all oaks acorns are present. Makes a good tree for wildlife because of its fruit. Height: 50-60' Spread: 40-50' Shape: Narrow, rounded, open Foliage: Dark green with felty white beneath Fall Foliage: Yellow-brown to red Exposure: Full Sun Zone: 4-8

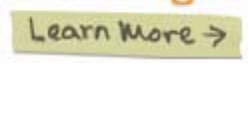
